Summary of B-Line routes

B1	City-Mona Vale
BN1	City-Mona Vale (night service)

Overview

The B-Line service was established on 26 November 2017 as part of a major service review on the Northern Beaches, when B1 commenced as a limited stop, frequently operating, major trunk route and many other services became feeders to it. Commencement of the route was accompanied by additional infrastructure at bus stops, in the form of real-time next-bus displays and car parks to facilitate park-and-ride.

Buses used on the service are purpose-built double deckers in a distinctive yellow livery.

A midnight-to-dawn service, BN1, was added on 20 December 2020.

Timeline

26 November 2017:

- New full time, limited stop trunk route B1 City (Wynyard) – Mona Vale commenced by State Transit Authority as part of major Northern Beaches service review.
- Service on previous trunk route L90 (renumbered 190X on 3 May 2020) significantly reduced & replaced by B1 (& supplementary 199).
- Supplemented by full time short-workings, 178 & 180.
- Supplemented by peak hour routes E75, E80, E83, E85, E88 & E89.
- 155, 156 & 185 became feeders to B1.
- Replaced most parts of 184, E84, L84, E86, E87, L88 & 190.
- Part of Contract Region 8.

20 December 2020: As part of introduction of Northern Beaches/Lower North Shore all-day frequent network:

- New midnight-to-dawn BN1 City (Queen Victoria Building) – Mona Vale commenced, sharing City – Mona Vale with B1.
- B1 & BN1 together provided a continuous service between the City & Mona Vale Monday-Sunday.
- Together with 199, B1 replaced remaining service on 190X

31 October 2021: Transferred to Keolis Downer Northern Beaches, as a result of competitive tendering for privatisation of Contract Region 8.

From Mona Vale (Barrenjoey Rd opposite Village Park) via reverse route to Bradfield Hwy [Sydney Harbour Bridge], then York St to Wynyard Park (City).

City (York St or Queen Victoria Building) – Mona Vale

From 20 December 2020

From City (Queen Victoria Building) (York St) via Druitt St, Clarence St, Erskine St, York St, Wynyard St, Carrington St (**Wynyard**), Margaret St, Clarence St, Bradfield Hwy [Sydney Harbour Bridge], Warringah Fwy, Falcon St, Military Rd (**Neutral Bay Junction, Cremorne Junction, Spit Junction**), Spit Rd (**Mosman**), Spit Bridge, Manly Rd, Burnt Bridge Creek Deviation, Condamine St (**Manly Vale**), Pittwater Rd (**Brookvale, Dee Why, Collaroy, Narrabeen, North Narrabeen**), Barrenjoey Rd to Village Park (Mona Vale).

From Mona Vale (Barrenjoey Rd opposite Village Park) via reverse route to Bradfield Hwy [Sydney Harbour Bridge], then York St to Market St (City).
